*Most trees listed will probably only reach 75% of the minimum mature heights and widths listed due to the constricted and compacted soil volumes typically encountered in the ROW. Limited rooting volume is the reason that particularly large species of trees such as cottonwoods, sycamores, and other elm varieties have been omitted from this list.
